Cub Camp is for those children ages, 3, 4 & 5 who will be enrolled in Grade K in September 2022

Children **MUST** be 3 by May 31, 2022 and **MUST** be toilet trained to be eligible and up to date vaccinations.

All campers are required to have a copy of their updated immunization record & small photo at the time of registration.

Early Registration Discount - Must register before May 28th limited space and will be on a first come first serve basis

FIRST COME FIRST SERVED—Registration will be accepted at Recreation Office Mondays - Fridays 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.

\$100 deposit is required for registration with full payment due by June 21st 2022
