Port Chester Camps strives to be a peanut/nut free environment and to inform you about our NUT FREE POLICY at Port Chester Cub Camp (Lyon Park) and Port Chester Day Camp (Park Avenue School). It is a policy that needs to be taken quite seriously because of its extremely dangerous consequences.

Nut allergies can be life threatening. It takes only the slightest smell, touch or ingestion to peanuts, peanut butter, and peanut oil, a product that 'may contain trace amounts of peanuts' or a product that has been 'processed in a plant that also manufactures peanut products', to cause a potential anaphylactic reaction. This can happen so easily – the hands of a friend who has just finished a peanut butter and jelly sandwich, or cookie from a bakery baked on the same pan as a peanut butter cookie. Again it only takes the slightest smell, touch or ingestion.

We are asking all of you to please keep this in mind when sending snacks/lunch for Cub Camp and Port Chester Day 2019. If you can take a few seconds to read the labels of any prepackaged product or to pick up the phone and give us a quick call with any questions it would be greatly appreciated.
